New membership applications are voted on by the members present at the meetings. CASC requires individuals to adhere to the ASCA bylaws, CASC bylaws, and policies. Club dues are based upon an annual membership which is renewed each year in January.

The membership criteria of CASC is consistent with the ASCA bylaws Article IV, with the following exceptions:

- A. All applications for membership will be in writing and will be submitted to the club BOD prior to being voted on by the membership at the next scheduled club meeting. Acceptance requires two-thirds of the voting member's present approval.
- B. Annual dues are \$10 for single voting membership, \$12.50 for dual membership, and \$3.00 for non-voting Junior membership.
 1. Membership dues are effective January 1st of each calendar year. The club secretary will notify each member in writing by December 1st of each calendar year. Membership dues are effective January 1st per CASC bylaws with the following policies:
 - a. All members are required to attend one meeting per year to be considered active.
 - b. All memberships are considered lapsed if dues are not received by the club secretary post marked by March 1st thus making the lapsed member a new applicant.
 - c. All new applicants for membership must be present at a meeting to introduce themselves before they will be voted on by the present membership. *Or have a sponsor to stand in for them at a meeting who is already a club member and who can introduce them to the membership.
